## **SUBANG CITY IN WEST JAVA TO STAGE ROUND THREE OF FIM ASIA SUPERMOTO CHAMPIONSHIP 2018**

*Gery-Mang Circuit in West Java to host third round following venue change*

**Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia 15 October 2018** – The FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship 2018 will move to Subang City, West Java for the third installation of the season this October. The round is scheduled to take place at the Gery-Mang Circuit, from 26 to 28 October 2018.

Located approximately 60 kilometres north of the West Javanese city of Bandung in Indonesia, the road racing Gery-Mang Circuit situated within the district of Subang City has been home to a number of local road-racing events in the area.

“In light of the unforeseen circumstances, we have had to make the decision to change the venue for the third round of the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship 2018. Working closely with the national sporting authority, Ikatan Motor Indonesia (IMI) and the local provincial authorities, we are excited to bring the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship to Indonesia again this season, this time at the Gery-Mang Circuit in Subang City, West Java. We would also like to thank the racing community and fans for their incredible and continued support. The growth of the Championship has been particularly strong in Indonesia on the back of a strong motorcycle racing heritage and continued growth of motorsports in the country. On that note, we are delighted and honoured to be able to organise this round at Subang City this October.” notes Andrew Ching, Chief Executive Officer of E-Plus Global Sdn Bhd, promoter and organiser of the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship.

Featuring Asia’s best talents, the title race for the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship 2018 is proving to be an exciting affair. The third round will also see a strong local contingent that includes seasoned-campaigner Pedro Wuner and Ivan Harry who will be looking to leverage on home ground advantage at the round in their bid to be ranked amongst Asia’s best. Meanwhile, following another perfect double following his two race wins at the Philippines round last month, Denmark’s Simon Vilhelmsen will be looking to strengthen his Championship and Best International Rider title bid at the Indonesian round. The Danish star will however face tough competition from Lewis Cornish of the United Kingdom who is also the defending champion, who will be looking to improve on his performance.

Proceedings for the third round of the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship 2018 will commence on Friday, 26 October with practice sessions, followed by Qualifying and SuperChrono sessions on Saturday, 27 October with the Moto 1 and Moto2 races taking place on Sunday, 28 October.

The Indonesian round of the FIM Asia SuperMoto Championship 2018 season at the Gery-Mang Circuit in Subang City will be streamed live through its OTT channel partners, twenty3.tv and twowheels.tv.
